Their office is working on field work, and hoping to turn over their books by the end of July to the Supervisor of Assessments. The Assessor's Office is predicting low residential complaints due to the housing market right now, however, they expect commercial complaints to be higher.

Highway Commissioner Conness reported the highway crews are working on culverts and their first round of mowing. The county site plan for the salt dome and storage shed has been completed, and the department will start work on the retention pond.

Administrative Assistance Paula Lind reported on the May General Assistance Program census and May Community Work and Job Training Program.
